With Safety Source you only choose what you need!**

PROGRAM PARAMETERS

Employees will need to have a recent (within two years) copy of their prescription (refraction) as provided to them by their eye doctor

Company will choose among three frame selection options

1. Allow only frames under a specific price (example under \$26.00 Basic Group, \$48.00 Standard Group)
2. Allow all Frame choices with no price restrictions (From Basic Group through Premium Group)
3. Establish a limited selection of frames to match specific company requirements (Brand and Function)

Polycarbonate Lens Material is the recommended and most cost effective. Glass and CR39 is also available. All will be in compliance with the American National Standard Z-87 for safety lenses.

Choose side shields from either permanently attached, removable or “Wrap-Around” frames with integral side shields designed into the frame

An allowable progressive lens decision should be made. Best Practice suggests matching the Safety Lens design to the individual’s streetwear progressive lens design. Alternatively only lower cost Bi-Focal lenses could be allowed.

LENS OPTIONS

The program administrator can select from among the many offerings of basic and special options. The recommended lens choice is Polycarbonate which has intrinsic UV protection and basic scratch resistance. Glass and CR 39 lenses can be chosen but the availability of product to satisfy some prescriptions is limited.

Review the Special Options page and decide which, if any, will be allowed. That determination will be communicated to the Dispensing Optician(s) servicing your program.

DISPENSING SERVICES

Safety Source offers On-Site dispensing services and guided Optical Outlet service. Both will provide the necessary fitting of Prescription Safety Eyewear in keeping with your individual program outline. Approved frame choices will be available for employee selection.

The Optical Professional will complete the SRX order form with a copy provided to the administrator.

Completed Safety Eyewear will be sent to the administrator for distribution.

Follow up fitting and adjustment can be provided as necessary.
